



## **Covid-19 Plan**

**Updated 8/19/22**

### In the case of a positive Covid-19 test

Isolation is required for individuals who test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status. Isolation will last for 5 calendar days after a positive Covid-19 test. If you have no symptoms, or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, including 24 hours with no fever and with no fever reducing medication, isolation will end and you may return to school on the 6th calendar day. Please refer to the Parent Student Handbook section on Communicable Diseases (page 33) for more detail on our school policy.

### In the case of exposure to someone who is positive for Covid-19

A notice will be sent from the school to people potentially exposed at school. Per current CDC guidelines, quarantine is not required, and masking is optional. Please refer to the CDC guidance below to see their current recommendations.
